

Golden Demon

Hook: Mustad 79580 or Daiichi 2220, Size 8

Thread: Black 6/0

Tail: Golden Pheasant Crest

Body: Flat Gold Tinsel

Rib: Oval Gold Tinsel – optional

Beard: Orange Hackle barbules or hackle tip

Wing: Bronze Mallard Flank Feather



1. Tie in thread near bend of the hook. Trim excess.
2. Tie in Golden Pheasant Crest Feather for tail. Length of tail is approximately hook gap.
Note: If an oval tinsel rib will be added, tie it in now on the bottom side of the hook.
3. Wrap thread forward covering excess tail material. Tie in gold tinsel.
4. Wrap tinsel back to the tail and then bring forward to the tie in point. Wrap five turns of oval gold tinsel for rib if it is being used. Trim excess tinsel.
5. Tie in a beard of orange hackle. Keep hackle on underside of hook. Beard should stop just short of hook point.
6. Cut approximately a 3/4" section of bronze mallard flank from the quill. The flank fibers should be the length of the hook shank. Fold the flank feather in half lengthwise, pinch it tightly and tie it in directly over the beard tie in point. Position the wing on the topline of the hook shank.
7. Trim off any excess flank feather and form a thread head. Whip finish.
8. Apply head cement.
9. Finished fly.
